

The Digital Futures Conference – Call for posters

We are now **welcoming poster submissions** for our upcoming conference on Wednesday 23rd March 2022. All submissions will be reviewed ahead of the conference and successful authors will be invited to present their work as a virtual poster at the conference.

We would welcome any posters on the theme of education and training in the digital age of psychiatry

Instructions on the preparation of abstracts:

1. Abstracts must be in English. Abbreviations may be used only if they are defined.
2. The abstract must not exceed 300 words (count does not include title or authors).
3. The abstract must not contain bibliographical references, tables, diagrams or appendices. If accepted for presentation at the conference these can be added at a later date.
4. Abstracts must be presented in five headed paragraphs in the following order: Aims and hypothesis, Background, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.
5. Abstracts could present either novel findings or new interpretations of existing data; Quality Improvement projects; Education and Training projects.
6. Submissions are accepted on the understanding that the work has been performed with the permission of any relevant ethical or legislative body. The authors should therefore ensure the work was conducted with appropriate ethical and governance safeguards.
7. All sources of financial sponsorship of the study should be stated at the end of the abstract.
